
Northminster will be collecting a love offering over the next two weeks for Ralph and Deb in celebration of their marriage.

As of May 31, NPC has:

- Received \$156,888.91 in pledges
- Received \$12,755.00 from regular (no pledge) givers
- Received \$8,747.72 in loose offerings
- Received \$12,051.41 for outreach programs
- Spent \$193,858.67 on budgeted and outreach expenses
- *Summary: NPC has received \$190,443.04 in total income and has spent a total of \$193,858.67 which leaves us with a deficit of \$3,415.63
