

BUILDING PROGRESS





FINANCIAL SUMMARY - AUGUST 2023

As of August 31, NPC has:

- Received \$262,889.63 in pledges
- Received \$33,070.00 from regular (no pledge) givers
- Received \$13,000.48 in loose offerings
- Received \$13,233.23 for outreach programs
- Spent \$327,565.23 on budgeted and outreach expenses

*Summary: NPC has received \$322,193.34 in total income and has spent a total of \$327,565.23 which leaves us with a deficit of \$5,371.89.
