FLINT RIVER UPDATES - RISE AGAINST HUNGER

Dear Presbyterians:

We couldn't believe the timing of the email we just received from Rise Against Hunger, and we wanted to share the REAL impact our food packaging event back in October has on people across the globe.

We just learned that as most of us are busily planning, shopping, and prepping for our Thanksgiving feast on Thursday, **our packaged meals are on their way to Burkina Faso.**

Burkina Faso, "the land of upright people," is a small landlocked country in western Africa known for its "simple and hardworking national character." Despite being a major exporter of gold and cotton, this region is one of Africa's poorest. Food insecurity there is driven by political uprisings, climate changes, and conflict.

To address some of the challenges faced by community members in Burkina Faso, **Rise Against Hunger partners with local organizations serving meals to children in school and early childhood development centers.**

The meals WE packaged will ensure these children have access to consistent nourishment, while also enabling them access to education - which will hold them in good stead for years to come.

Flint River Faithful, this Thanksgiving your FRP Staff gives thanks for YOU. For all the

ways you help make our presbytery strong, faithful, prayerful, and worshipful - from serving on committees, to hosting educational events, from joining in book clubs, to providing meals to children in West Africa - we are THANKFUL.
